Dear Valued Customer,

China's General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) have revised the requirements for dis-insection certificates of US origin cargo for China destination. According to the revised policy dis-insection certification is required only for cargo originating from the State of Florida.

We would like to remind you that dis-insection is the shipper or consignee's responsibility and may be carried out either at cargo origin or at destination in China. If dis-insection is performed at the Chinese port of discharge, it may possibly delay cargo availability. All costs are for the account of cargo as we are not involved in this procedure.
