



Inspection Requirements in the Customs Trade Partnership Against Terrorism Program (CTPAT)

Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is to advise that as of January 1, 2020, CTPAT will implement additional requirements on all CTPAT members. In addition to current requirements, containers will need to be inspected for visible pest contamination immediately prior to stuffing. Wood used for blocking and bracing must also be in compliance with current Wood Packaging Materials (WPM) regulations, specifically meeting International Plant Protection Convention's (IPPC) International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures No. 15 (ISPM 15).
