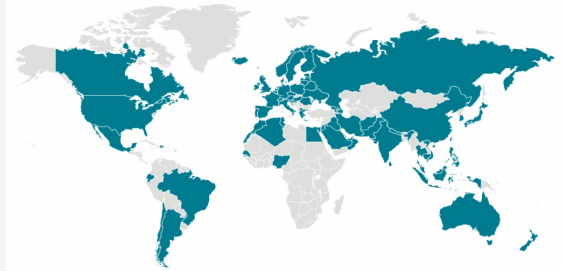




3/5/2020 | Coronavirus Industry Updates

Delays and Operations

The traditional slowdown of activity in Asia during the post Lunar New Year period has been further impacted by the Coronavirus. There are several blank sailings from China which is causing a slow down in equipment arrival into the U.S. causing space and equipment issues for export shipments. Though vessel and terminal operations in the Greater China Area continue to operate normally; Customs houses, ocean terminal depots, and all off-dock depots remain open. It is understood that factories are still working with limited capacity and transport limitations are still being applied by some local governments as preventative measurements.
